INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Confirm the voltage and current draw of your connected load to the control output is consistent with the design specifications of this product and that your application will not exceed the maximum load capacity listed.

1 OPEN THE RECEIVER LID

Open the receiver lid to gain access to the terminal connectors and dip switches.

3 PAIR WITH TRANSMITTER & SELECT MODE The MXR-4 is compatible with other MIGRO® MXT-4 transmitters(Tx). Match the receiver dip switch settings to the settings on the desired transmitter.

MODE SWITCH:

Each Channel can be indivudualy set to either Momentary or Latching Mode. Select the mode desired for your application.








) LOCATE WIRING TERMINALS

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OPEN THE TRANSMITTER LID


Open the Transmitter lid to gain access to the terminal connectors and dip switches.

ATTENTION !!!

PERFORM A BENCH TEST PRIOR TO INSTALLING THE SYSTEM

Ensuring your MIGRO Xtended Range Wireless Controller is functioning prior to field installation is required by the manufacturer. Environmental and application specific conditions may cause communication error and a bench test will ensure that the equipment is functioning properly.

WARNING: Never operate the transmitter or receiver without antennas

TESTING PROCEDURE

NOTE: Transmitter and Receiver antennas shall be mounted facing the same vertical position (same pattern polarity), even when there is no line of sight.



1 CLEARANCE

Separate the Transmitter and Receiver at least 6 feet (2 meter) apart.

ANTENNAS

Connect the antenna on the Transmitter and Receiver.

3 POWER SOURCE


Connect the Transmitter and the Receiver to a 12VDC power source.

/ CLOSE INPUTS

On the transmitter terminals, momentarily close INPUT CH1 with a wire jumper and verify that the receiver relay energizes. Repeat for each channel.

INSTALLATION

TIP: Install the antenna as high as possible, clear from obstructions or metal structures.
